



Barbican Wildlife Garden

The Barbican Wildlife Garden is one of three residents' Gardens on the Barbican Estate in the City of London. It lies within the Barbican and Golden Lane Estate Conservation Area and is classified as a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation.



“Since we started recording sightings about five years ago, we now view the Garden in a different way. Before we just gardened but now we take pleasure in noting what bird is on the feeder, what slug we’ve seen under a log and what has been eating holes in a plant. We’re more focused and although the Garden rarely has unusual occupants it’s the ordinary that is important as much as the extraordinary.”

Over 300 species of birds, mammals, amphibians and invertebrates have been recorded at BWG, including several listed as under severe threat in London.
